

Re: Risk Management for Tokens issued by Black Air 777 Group PLC

The following is a summary of the Risk Management program developed for the tokens of BlackAir777 Group PLC., Technology provided by AGURA financial technology platforms.

Security is brought to the investment of a token by (a) careful selection of suppliers and service companies we have chosen to partner, (b) minimizing of operational risks through proper structure and process, and (c) risk transfer through surety and insurance arrangements. A more detailed summary is provided below:

- Supplier Risk
 - use of a Fin-tech Bank, not subject to regulations that can restrict money flow, and increase credit risk
 - currency selection
 - exchange selection
 - banking jurisdiction, and exchange jurisdiction
 - trader selection
 - regulatory risk
- Operational Risk
 - Management decision process
 - Committee and Board process
 - Operational management objectives and close management
 - suppliers and service company selection
 - Risk transfer strategy
 - Capital investment, approval process
 - Operational Reserve Fund
- Risk Transfer
 - Surety Bond – is primary or first of security for the token
 - It is secured by through two means, exceeding requirements
 - collateral assets, including cash
 - insurance policy(s)
 - Regulated suppliers for most services, including banking, surety, insurance.
 - Use Lloyds brokerage and other reputable insurance providers.

The Risk Management Program has been designed to protect the liabilities, assets, and bring financial stability to the Company. It will be flexible through the start-up period, and as growth and changes are experienced. Policy or Surety limits will closely match the purchased tokens, which includes contractual obligations of the Company.

The risk management program has a foundation of thorough risk evaluation and appropriate action to address and transfer the risks of the operation. Proper monitoring of the risk management strategy on an ongoing basis, particularly as the company growth or with new operational lines.
